It shall be a condition of this Permit that:

- (a) Messrs. Elin Group Limited operates the following aircraft type:
 - (i) **One (1) Agusta Westland A109E Power Elite**
Reg. No: 5N-BVT
- (b) No additional aircraft apart from the one(s) listed above shall be operated under this permit without prior approval of the Nigeria Civil Aviation Authority (NCAA);
- (c) The aircraft shall not be used for carriage of passenger(s), cargo or mail for hire or reward;
- (d) In operating international flights, all flights must leave and enter Nigeria through Customs Airport;
- (e) Prior permission of the Nigeria Civil Aviation Authority (NCAA) and the appropriate aeronautical authorities of the foreign countries concerned must be sought before any flight outside Nigeria is undertaken.
- (f) The aircraft shall be operated in accordance with all laws, regulations and rules for the time being in force in Nigeria as well as the Standards and Recommended Practices (SARPs) of ICAO.
- (g) A monthly return giving details of all flights undertaken during the preceding month shall be submitted to the Ministry of Aviation and Aerospace Development and NCAA not later than the 15th of the following month and shall include these details:
 - (i) date of flight;
 - (ii) registration number of aircraft;
 - (iii) points between which the flights were conducted;
 - (iv) total flying time involved;
 - (v) total cargo;
 - (vi) names of passenger carried.
- (h) The holder must have adequate resources and ensure capabilities for the maintenance and safe operation of the aircraft.
- (i) Holder shall file with the Authority, a true copy of every contract or agreement affecting air transportation or any modification or cancellation thereof, between the holder and any other person(s).

- (j) The holder of this Permit shall pay staff salaries as and when due.
- (k) Failure to comply with any of the conditions above (a to j) may result to the revocation or suspension of this Permit.
- (l) This Permit **which is not transferable** may be renewed at the end of three (3) years upon application.
